Bloomfield Township doesn't belong to SOCCRA

SOCRRA is not an independent entity that other communities just pay a membership fee for, it's actually a municipal owned corporation – formed and owned by member communities back in the early 1950's who joined together to create their own facilities for disposing of and handling their solid waste. Each community, at that time, contributed capital funding to build a large landfill, an incinerator and transfer station. In the early 1990's they morphed into the recycling business and also built their own Materials Recovery Facility. These facilities were all built and continue to be maintained using the tax dollars of the communities that make up the Authority. The law governing these types of Authorities does allow for other communities to join, however, they must invest or buy into all of the infrastructure and liabilities of the Authority. For any community to join SOCRRA at today's prices, it would cost millions and would not be a cost-effective measure for our community at this time.
