This report provides a summary of many arrests, incidents, events and other items of significance occurring in Bloomfield Township. However, it does not include every incident reported to the Police Department. It is possible for publicity to hinder some criminal investigations. In these situations, we do not release information unless it is in the community's best interest or we are certain it will not compromise an investigation.

Summary:

During the timeframe of October 20, 2025, through October 26, 2025, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 503 calls for service, 193 of which were traffic stops.

Traffic Crashes:

Officers investigated 53 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 31 Property Damage Crashes, 7 Personal Injury Crashes, 9 Hit and Run Crashes, 5 Private Property Crashes, 0 Car vs. Deer Crashes, and 1 Non-UD-10 Crash.

25-21792 Retail Fraud

6520 Telegraph Road (Sephora)

On October 23, 2025, the Bloomfield Township Police Department took a report of a Retail Fraud that occurred on October 21, 2025. Employees at Sephora, 6520 Telegraph Road, reported that two unknown females entered the store and stole several items by concealing them in purses and on their person. The females were described as black females between 25-40 years old. Combined the females walked out with over \$1,800 in product. This case was turned over to the Bloomfield Township Police Investigations Unit and is currently under investigation. 25-21772 Malicious Destruction of Property 7273 Wing Lake Road and 6490 Wing Lake Road

On October 23, 2025, the Bloomfield Township Police Department took a report of Malicious Destruction of Property at both the Booth Center, 7273 Wing Lake Road and Wing Lake Developmental Center, 6490 Wing Lake Road. The school located graffiti spray painted on the exterior walls, a shed, and one of the dumpsters. The word "Love" was spray painted in red paint. A can of red spray paint was collected and is being processed for evidence. Bloomfield Township's Investigations Unit is currently investigating this crime in connection with report #25-21710. 25-21710 Malicious Destruction of Property

7000 block of Franklin Road

On October 22, 2025, the Bloomfield Township Police Department took two reports of Malicious Destruction of Property at homes under construction in the 7000 block of Franklin Road. In one instance the words "Love" were spray painted in black paint on the front of the home. In the other instance the word "Love" was spray painted in white paint on an interior wall. 25-21573 Retail Fraud 2105 S Telegraph Road (Dick's Sporting Goods)

On October 20, 2025, at approximately 4:45 p.m., the Bloomfield Township Police Department responded to a Retail Fraud that just occurred at Dick's Sporting Goods located at 2105 S Telegraph Road. The described middle-aged black male selected over \$500 worth of Nike apparel. The suspect approached the check out counter and attempted to pay for the items, but had an issue with his credit card. The male stepped away from the counter and when the cashier was distracted left with the merchandise failing to pay for any of it. This case was turned over to the Bloomfield Township Investigations Unit and is currently being reviewed.
