Weekly Media Report

September 14, 2026

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This report provides a summary of many arrests, incidents, events and other items of significance occurring in Bloomfield Township. However, it does not include every incident reported to the Police Department. It is possible for publicity to hinder some criminal investigations. In these situations, we do not release information unless it is in the community's best interest or we are certain it will not compromise an investigation.

Summary:

During the timeframe of September 7, 2026, through September 13, 2026, Bloomfield Township Officers handled 517 calls for service, 148 of which were traffic stops.

Traffic Crashes:

Officers investigated 33 total traffic crashes during this timeframe: 14 Property Damage Crashes, 8 Personal Injury Crashes, 7 Hit and Run Crashes, 3 Private Property Crashes, 0 Car vs. Deer Crashes, and 1 Non-UD-10 Crash.

On September 13, 2026, the Bloomfield Township Police Department took a report of three Larcenies from Automobiles in the 300 block of Fremont Street. The victim stated that three vehicles on his property were gone through and had property was missing. All three vehicles were unlocked. Burglary

1571 S Opdyke Road (Dollar Tree)

On September 13, 2026, at 3:37 a.m., Bloomfield Township Officers were dispatched to the Dollar Tree, located at 1571 S Opdyke Road, for an active burglary alarm. Officers arrived on scene to find that the front glass door had been smashed in with a rock. Video surveillance footage revealed that at approximately 3:30 a.m., a black male on a peddle bike arrived at the store, smashed the front glass door, and entered the business. Employees reported an air compressor and an electronic tablet missing from the manager's officer. Retail Fraud
2105 S Telegraph Road (Dick's Sporting Goods)

On September 9, 2026, at 9:41 p.m., Officers from the Bloomfield Township Police Department were dispatched to Dick's Sporting Goods, located at 2105 S Telegraph Road, for a Retail Fraud in progress. Officers arrived on scene and were alerted by store staff that black female and a black male, both 20-30 years old, had fled the store with a Stanley 40oz tumbler, Boggs bags, and a North Face backpack. Bloomfield Township Officers and a K9 canvassed the area, but did not locate anyone matching the suspects' description. Approximately \$340 worth of merchandise was stolen. This case was assigned to the Bloomfield Township Police Investigations Unit and is currently under investigation.
